Understanding the Statement of Results

All Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE) candidates will receive a Statement of Results. This is the document you should use when checking candidate results.

The Statement of Results gives you two main pieces of information about a candidate's performance:

- Their overall score on the Cambridge **English Scale**
- Their score on the Cambridge English Scale for each of the four skills (Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking) and Use of English

Candidates also receive a CEFR* level and a grade.

Cambridge English: Advanced reports on the Cambridge English Scale between 142 and 210.

1 Overall score

This is the overall Cambridge English Scale score for the whole exam. It is the average of the five individual scores a candidate receives for the four skills and Use of English.


The overall score is the most important piece of information when setting requirements to ensure that you ask for the exact level of English you need.

2 Individual scores

Candidates receive a Cambridge English Scale score for each of the four skills (Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking) and Use of English. With these individual scores it is easy for you to specify the level of English you need in a particular language skill.

Certificate

As well as a Statement of Results, candidates who achieve a score of 180-210 will receive a Certificate in Advanced English. Candidates who score between 160 and 179 will receive a Cambridge English certificate stating that they demonstrated ability at CEFR Level B2.



Results Verification Service

You can rely on our free online Results Verification Service to guickly and securely verify a candidate's Cambridge English exam results. Results are uploaded to the service as soon as they are released.

Candidates who want an institution to be able to verify their results simply provide them with their Candidate ID Number and Candidate Secret Number (printed on their Confirmation of Entry) and the institution can log in to view their Statement of Results.
