



Cambridge English: Young Learners, also known as *Young Learners English (YLE)*, gives you three fun, activity-based tests you can use to motivate younger students and show parents how well their children are learning.

Cambridge English: Preliminary for Schools, also known as *Preliminary English Test (PET) for Schools*, shows a student can use everyday English at an intermediate level.

Cambridge English: First for Schools

Cambridge English: First for Schools, also known as *First Certificate in English (FCE) for Schools*, shows that a student can use everyday written and spoken English at an upper-intermediate level for work or study purposes.

Cambridge English: Key for Schools

Cambridge English: Key for Schools, also known as *Key English Test (KET) for Schools*, shows a student can use everyday English at a basic level.


The next step is **Cambridge English: Advanced**, also known as *Certificate in Advanced English (CAE)* – the internationally recognised standard to study and work in English-speaking countries.
