Getting the most from every moment of learning

Every single moment spent with a language learner is important. That's why we integrate learning and assessment, to help teachers measure, guide and support progress.

Learning takes place at different rates for different individuals. This can make it difficult for teachers to know how learning is progressing and where to focus. An approach is needed, therefore, that focuses not only on teaching and learning, but also on assessment. Assessment in this case doesn't simply mean tests, but any activity that provides information about student or whole class learning.

By assessing where learners are a teacher can provide evidence of progress and actionable feedback to motivate learners and show them what they need to do next to achieve their goals.

The integral role of assessment in language teaching and learning

Assessment is integral to language learning and carries a range of different purposes. Exams and tests enable learners to prove their skills to the world, but assessment also helps shape programmes of learning and guide the decisions that need to be made to help learners improve.

Using assessment to inform teaching has a significant impact on the effectiveness of learning, and on student motivation.

Assessment should not be seen as separate to learning, therefore, or as something that just takes place at the end of a course of learning. Ongoing assessment throughout the learning journey helps teachers to identify individual and collective learning gaps, enabling them to plan lessons that are more targeted and responsive to student needs.

Integrating learning and assessment to improve outcomes

Integrated learning and assessment (ILA) is the combination of teaching, learning and assessment methods to plan, measure and improve outcomes. Backed by our research, we believe that providing evidence of progress and actionable feedback is the best way to help learners succeed. These are two of the four 'pillars' that underpin learner success and are at the heart of successfully integrating learning and assessment in the classroom. They are supported by having clear learning objectives and tailored follow-up activities planned by teachers.
