Four key skills

These exams ensure children's learning is focused on all four communication skills - listening, reading, writing and speaking. The speaking test is face-to-face with a friendly Cambridge examiner, helping children to feel confident talking in English.



Fun progression

Preparing for and taking these exams is designed to be a fun and motivating experience for children that builds their confidence for future exams. Familiar topics and activities like colouring help children learn to enjoy proving their ability.



Learning milestones

Level-based exams provide milestones for children to reach and celebrate as they learn English. These milestones are linked to the CEFR, giving you and your child a clear understanding of their English abilities at each level and what they need to do next.



Celebration

There is no pass or fail. The exams are an opportunity for each child to show how they've developed and what they can do. Every child receives a certificate that recognises their achievement in all four skills.





A child's first, fun steps in English

Pre A1 Starters

This exam represents Pre A1 on the CEFR scale and introduces children to everyday written and spoken English. At this level, children can spell their name and say how old they are.

A1 Movers

This exam represents A1 on the CEFR scale and progresses to simple conversational English. At this level, children can answer questions about their everyday life.

A2 Flyers

This exam represents A2 on the CEFR scale and progresses further to building and linking sentences. At this level, children can talk about things they've done.
