Workshop Details

Workshop 1: “Successful exam preparation for B2 First & C1 Advanced students”

As a teacher coaching your students to take the B2 First or C1 Advanced exam, you may have questions concerning how best to prepare them. The purpose of this short workshop is to shed light on some of the key strategies students can employ to help them do well in the Reading and Use of English, and Writing papers. In particular, we will look at the assessment criteria which Cambridge examiners use when marking writing. These criteria can be used in class to give targeted feedback to your students.
