Results and reporting

Accurate and easy-to-read results

Results reports are easy to read and applicants receive a CEFR level, the international standard for describing language ability. Our unique Cambridge English Scale score also provides more information on a candidate's performance in each skill. Can Do statements are also included to indicate what someone could be expected to do at their level. Setting different ability benchmarks for different jobs has never been simpler.

1 Results include an overall CEFR level and Cambridge English Scale score, as well as results for each of the skills tested.
