



A2 Flyers – Beltrán

Please read this and watch [this video](#) of Beltrán doing an A2 Flyers Speaking test.

Beltrán uses a range of vocabulary to deal with all test tasks. He uses a range of simple structures and, although there are some mistakes, meaning is clear. In part 2, he produces ‘George name is Socks’. He responds at word, phrase or longer utterance level. In part 2, he produces ‘George has a pup’, ‘there are 4’. He can join ideas with a range of simple linkers (e.g. and, but, when, then, because), he produces ‘then, the girl give the umbrella to the boy, and the Mum and the boy are in a bus stop with the umbrella’, ‘and then the girl give the umbrella to another’.

Beltrán is mostly intelligible. He has some control of stress and intonation at both word and longer utterance levels.

Beltrán responds appropriately to all instructions, questions and visual prompts and very little support is required. In part 4, he is able to ask a backup question in order to give some information about the kitchen. He responds promptly with only natural hesitation and pausing.
