Tips for adding your qualification to your CV

- Avoid using imprecise terms such as 'fluent'.
- Give your score on the Cambridge English Scale and the CEFR level. These are far more precise and can be compared across all Cambridge English qualifications.
- Be sure to mention the full name of your qualification and who it is from e.g. Cambridge English B2 First.

Add your qualification to LinkedIn

How to add your Cambridge English qualification to your LinkedIn profile.

1. Go to the LinkedIn section of cambridgeenglish.org or search for LinkedIn within your country's Cambridge Assessment English website.

Click on the LinkedIn icon for your qualification, then enter the following information:

- 1 **Name:** add the name of your qualification and your Cambridge English scale score. For example: Cambridge English B2 First – Score 170
- 2 **Issuing Organization:** add Cambridge Assessment English
- 3 **If appropriate, tick 'This certification does not expire'.**
- 4 **Issue Date:** add when you sat the exam (month and year).
- 5 **In Credential ID:** fill in your **ID Number** and **Secret Number**. These are the numbers you used to check your results online. You can find them on your Confirmation of Entry. Employers can use these to validate your qualification.
- 6 **Credential URL:** add the appropriate page for your qualification from our website. You can find them here: www.cambridgeenglish.org/exams-and-tests

2. **In the section Accomplishments/Languages** Specify the *LinkedIn Level* corresponding to the Cambridge English Scale score on your certificate.
